- 014/2017     Minutes of the meeting 23<sup>rd</sup> January  
Amended to record Clerks salary increase to £1900 from 1/4/17 and note of  
the Powys County Council decision re weight limit in Criggion Lane. All in  
favour they be accepted and signed by the Chair
- Matters arising**
- 015/2017     Highways  
Dropped drain at Pecknall Lane. The drain is still not completed -whatever  
was done was not to the correct one – Clerk to raise again with Highways  
Resurfacing at Back Lane to the Quarry- this is on the programme but no  
further updates – Escalate that the area between Lower farm and the main  
road is particularly bad  
Pot holes on the road above The Hawthorns – has been raised  
Gritting up to Bausley estate – ask for this to be put into the first stage of the  
program and to advise if there is a cost implication  
Community speed checks noted in Coedway -They have gone through the  
training and report findings to the Police who nay send letters to those  
recorded  
Hedge on stretch by the Mount Llandrinio came across the road in the storms  
and was sorted out by Highways – request further work as it still impedes the  
road  
Query on the speed limit on the road up to and past the school as signs appear  
to indicate it is national speed limit. Requested a review
